A.V. Studio FAQs

Does GPL offer classes on A.V. Studio equipment?

The library is working to create training opportunities with area professionals and makers. Keep an eye on our events calendar for more information. First time users are encouraged to spend their first reservation becoming acquainted with the equipment. Learning in the space is intended to be self-directed.

We have also made available all user guides and instruction manuals for your convenience. Library staff will be on hand to get you started and will be happy to guide you to additional resources, online tutorials, and classes available through Lynda.com.

Do I need a library card to use the A.V. Studio?

A valid library card is needed to use the A.V. Studio and to check out equipment specifically for the space, BUT if you don't have a card, it's no problem!

Visit our 2nd Floor Help Desk to check out equipment using a guest pass. For A.V. Studio use without a card you will also need to sign a use contract and let us hold onto your picture ID while you're using the resources in The Studio.

How can I reserve time in the A.V. Studio?

Reserve time in the A.V. Studio by visiting our 2nd Floor Help Desk, calling 317-885-5036, or filling out our online reservation form.

You must be 13+ years of age, or accompanied by an adult, to reserve the A.V. Studio or to check out Community Equipment for use in The Studio.

How long are reservation times in the A.V. Studio?

The A.V. Studio can be reserved in two-hour blocks of time up to twice per week.

How can I take my files home?

Makers can bring either an external hard drive or SD card to save their files to depending on their project. The library has SD cards and SD card readers available for checkout for use in the space only. Projects can be saved temporarily to a GPL SD card and then transferred to the cloud or a USB drive brought from home.
