Community Equipment FAQs

Does GPL offer classes on community equipment?

The Studio focuses on offering access to equipment and supplies so that patrons can start their own, self-guided, making journey. For this reason, classes are not our primary focus. Library staff will be on hand to get you started and will be happy to guide you to additional resources, online tutorials, and classes available through Lynda.com.

We have also made available all user guides and instruction manuals for your convenience.

Can I check out community equipment if I don't have a library card?

A valid library card is needed to check out equipment, BUT if you don't have a card, it's no problem! Visit our 2nd Floor Help Desk to check out kits and equipment using a guest pass. We'll just need to hang on to your picture ID while you're using the resources in The Studio.

You must be 13+ years of age, or accompanied by an adult, to check out Community Equipment for use in The Studio.

Is Community Equipment free to use?

Yes! Equipment is free to use in the space. If you are using our editing computers or converting photographs or VHS to digital, you will need to save your items to the cloud or onto a USB drive brought from home.

Can I reserve equipment?

Community equipment and kits are available on a first come, first serve basis. They are not available to be reserved.

How long can I use an editing computer?

Computers can be reserved in two-hour blocks of time up to twice per week. They are available on a first come, first served basis and cannot be reserved.
